

INTERNSHIP MATCH RATES BY PROGRAM BETWEEN 2006-2011, AS REPORTED ON PROGRAM WEBSITES

An important decision when applying to graduate school pertains to the likelihood of successfully obtaining a predoctoral internship in the very competitive internship application process. In the past ten years, approximately 75% of applicants match to internships. The attached listing is based on data listed on all APA accredited programs' websites regarding the percentage of students who matched at APA accredited internships. Because so few students apply each year from the majority of programs, small differences (i.e., within 10%) in match rates are likely meaningless. However, this list may prove useful when examining more substantial differences in match rates and considering different possible graduate programs.
